Training Content:

The training will incorporate lecture and experiential learning on various topics including:

- Prevention in its Historic Context
- Research and Planning
- Evaluation
- Media (Media Advocacy, Media Literacy and Social Marketing)
- Human Development/Culture
- Prevention Ethics

Credentialing and Continuing Education:

Participants are required to attend all four days of the training. Upon completion of the full training, participants will be awarded a certificate for a total of 30 hours.

The PSCBW has approved hours from SAPST to be used toward the initial application for the entry-level Associate Prevention Professional (APP) credential or the internationally-recognized Certified Prevention Professional (CPP) credential. Hours may also be used to fulfill CPP continuing education requirements. Clock hours may also be available.

Register by Friday, March 16, 2012. You are encouraged to register earlier than the deadline since space is limited.
