The training will incorporate lecture and experiential learning on various topics including:

- Media (Media Advocacy, Media Literacy and Social Marketing)
- Human Development/Culture
- Prevention Ethics

### Credentialing and Continuing Education:

Participants are required to attend all four days of the training. Upon completion of the full training, participants will be awarded a certificate for a total of 30 hours.

The PSCBW has approved hours from SAPST to be used toward the initial application for the entry-level Associate Prevention Professional (APP) credential or the internationally-recognized Certified Prevention Professional (CPP) credential. Hours may also be used to fulfill CPP continuing education requirements. Clock hours may also be available.
