#### **Step 2:** Enter data for Process Questions

In 2018, process questions for the CORE survey start at Q22 / Q26 (depending whether a parent) in Survey Monkey.

#### Please be sure to answer questions 22 & 24.

We need to know in which language the survey was administered and the date it was taken. If you are administering hard copy surveys via a method that makes it impossible to ascertain the exact date (e.g., leaving copies at a local business with a box to collect completed surveys), please ballpark as best you can. Even the month will help greatly.

#### Question 23 is optional.

Coordinators often find it helpful to number each survey and indicate who entered it. That way, if any issues arise (e.g., you're not sure if some surveys have or haven't been entered), we can help you troubleshoot to ensure data quality.

# DATA ENTRY FOR SURVEYS TAKEN IN OTHER LANGUAGES

## Same as above, but one caution: Take care where the online format is slightly different than the hard copy format

There are a couple places where the response options go left-to-right on the PDF, but are top-to-bottom on the online survey.

For example:
