ENGLISH-LANGUAGE SURVEY DATA ENTRY

Step 1: Enter data from survey questions

The Survey Monkey [Data-Entry Link](#) begins at question #1 of the survey:

Step 2: Enter data for Process Questions

In 2021, process questions for the CORE survey start at Q16 / Q20 (depending whether a parent) in Survey Monkey.

Please be sure to answer questions 27 & 29.

We need to know in which language the survey was administered and the date it was taken. If you are administering hard copy surveys via a method that makes it impossible to ascertain the exact date (e.g., leaving copies at a local business with a box to collect completed surveys), please ballpark as best you can. Even the month will help greatly.

Question 28 is optional.

Coordinators often find it helpful to number each survey and indicate who entered it. That way, if any issues arise (e.g., you're not sure if some surveys have or haven't been entered), we can help you troubleshoot to ensure data quality.

DATA ENTRY FOR SURVEYS TAKEN IN OTHER LANGUAGES

Same as above, but one caution: Take care where the online format is slightly different than the hard copy format

There are a couple places where the response options go left-to-right on the PDF, but are top-to-bottom on the online survey.

For example:

16. How do you currently identify yourself? Select all that apply.

Male	Female	Transgender	Questioning / not sure of my gender identity	Something else fits better
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21. How do you currently identify yourself?

- Female

The PDFs all share the same layout, so if in doubt while entering data for non-English languages with which you may not be familiar, look at the English PDF layout to determine the response option order. **Please note that the numbering on the hard copy survey may not match the numbering on the electronic Survey Monkey version.
