## Survey Selection in Minerva 2.0

#### **Purpose**

The Survey Selection Guide is a tool to assist contractors in identifying surveys that measure intended outcomes associated with the risk/protective factors (intervening variables) and measurable objectives (local conditions) identified during the strategic planning process. This tool is intended to be used toward the end of the strategic planning process, at the Evaluation step, to identify surveys that will evaluate effectiveness of programs. Once selected, DBHR and contractors can use these surveys to evaluate whether outcomes are achieved, the progress from start to finish of a program, as well as any need for process improvements. Through the assessment of this data, DBHR and contractors refine and better individualize prevention services within communities. These surveys have been validated through a rigorous process at DBHR with the assistance of multiple partner agencies.

#### Contractual requirements for survey administration\*

\*Please refer to your contract or agreement for full text and details, when applicable, for requirements on reporting and survey implementation.

Per contractual obligations, contractors shall report on all required evaluation tools identified in Minerva 2.0 that measure the primary program objective.

- 1. Pre/Post tests are required for all recurring direct service programs.
- 2. The Coalition Assessment Tool is required to be completed by coalition members.
- **3.** Specific surveys for Information Dissemination or Environmental strategies/programs based on a specific program are to be determined and approved in the contractor's Action Plan.

Special situations and exceptions regarding evaluation tools identified in Minerva include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Contractor may negotiate with the Contract Manager or designee to reduce multiple administrations of surveys to individual participants.
- 2. Participants in recurring program groups in which the majority of participants are younger than ten (10) years old on the date of that group's first service.

#### Contractual requirements for program outcomes\*

\*Please refer to your contract or agreement for full text and details, when applicable, for requirements on program evaluation and outcomes. The language below was modified to reflect the language of the new Minerva 2.0 system.

Per contractual obligations, contractors shall ensure program results show positive outcomes for at least half of the participants in each program group as determined by Cohort with individual participant entry type.

- 1. "Positive outcomes" means that at least half of the participants in a group report positive improvement or maintenance as determined by the program measurable objective between pre and post-tests.
- 2. Positive outcomes will be determined using the pre-test and post-test data reported in Minerva 2.0.
- **3.** Evaluation of Minerva 2.0 data will occur on the 15th of the month following the final date of service for each group.

#### Minerva functionality


In Minerva 2.0, surveys are attached to Cohorts for a given Program & Strategy and are linked to the Logic Model specified for that Program & Strategy and Cohort. Minerva 2.0 will list survey(s) that measure the identified Local Condition and align with the Intervening Variable per the Logic Model for the chosen Program & Strategy. Questions within the listed surveys have been identified by DBHR and DBHR partner researchers as measuring the effectiveness of prevention services.

#### **Important note**

In Minerva 2.0, surveys can be attached **only to Cohorts** and **not** Campaigns or Individual Activities.

#### Tip to identify existing Intervening Variable and Local Condition

To check which Intervening Variable and Local Condition combination has been selected for a given Cohort, click on an existing Cohort to navigate to the Edit Cohort screen. Under the "Logic Model" section of the Edit Cohort page, the drop-down menu entitled "Contributing Factor" displays the combined Intervening Variable and Local Condition chosen for this cohort. For example, the screen snip below captures a program Cohort with the **Intervening Variable** (R) Family Management Problems and the **Local Condition** Family management skills. The Contributing Factor selection reads "(R) Family Management Problems => Family management skills."



#### Ready to identify potential surveys?

Use the **Survey Selection Guide** which begins on the next page to identify surveys. The first column includes risk and protective factors (i.e., the **Intervening Variables**) and the second column lists measurable objectives (i.e., the **Local Conditions**). Use CTRL-F to quickly search for key phrases (e.g. search for *healthy beliefs* to find protective factors that include healthy beliefs).
