

How to Identify Marijuana Products

There are currently no regulations on medical marijuana products that appeal to youth or that look like food. Almost any food or candy product can be made to include marijuana including candies, gummy bears, chocolate, cookies, brownies, sodas or other drinks. It is best to tell kids not to accept any food or candy products from anyone unless they know it is from a safe source.



Marijuana products are usually only sold at marijuana stores. Many of them have a Green Cross sign or may have the words "Marijuana", "MMJ" "420", "Safe Access", "Collective Garden" or "Cannabis".



You should **not** find products containing marijuana at any large grocery store like Safeway, QFC, Grocery Outlet, SAARS, or Red Apple.

Some things to look for on packages are the following:

"THC" - this is the active ingredient in marijuana

The words "Cannabis", "Marijuana", "420", "Hash"
