A Risk Category Rank of "High" indicates that the referenced School District Risk Score was in the top 25% of School Districts in the risk category
A Risk Category Rank of "Very High" indicates that the referenced School District Risk Score was in the top 10% of School Districts in the risk category

Review considerations:

- 1) To get a overall sense of risk severity across all categories, examine the 'Composite Risk Percentile'. It reflects what % of School Districts had a Composite Risk Score LOWER, than the referenced School District.
- 2) To get a sense of whether the community is appropriately sized (not too big, not too little), examine the 'Population: Age 0-17' column.
- 3) To ensure that the composite is meaningful, examine then 'Indicators with data' column. Composite scores based on few indicators should be interpreted with caution. In total, 29 indicators were used.
