Later, after some life changes, he and his family served the Lutheran Church of Bolivia for three years. Then seminary and ordination in 1984. Alex has served Faith Lutheran in Leavenworth for the past 15 years. It is a congregation which has taught him the critical importance of Justice, Mercy, and Peacemaking. Alex has been involved in learning and teaching cultural competency and racism for over a decade.
