CPWI Funding Adjustment

CPWI funding adjustment

- ▶ Based upon your feedback, we have been advocating for increased funding from a more stable funding source.
- ▶ Intent of funding adjustment is to provide an adjustment to coalition coordinator salaries/benefits or increase program services.
 - ▶ Coalitions should have a voice in this process.
 - ▶ Funds may be used for other purposes as agreed upon by the coalition.
- ▶ Receiving admin as part of this allocation is an option.
- ▶ **Note, this funding is not guaranteed until in contract.*

The why

- ▶ Commitment to **high-quality prevention services** to include contracting documents that reflect this.
- ▶ At the start of the biennium we faced some bumps in the road!
- ▶ Over the last year we've been working to create the best version of our contract.
- ▶ By setting up a good template now, we do not anticipate major changes at the start of the next biennium.
 - ▶ Possibility to just amend the contract at the start of the biennium to allocate new funds rather than execute brand new contracts.

Funding timelines vary

- ▶ **SFY:** July 1 – June 30 annually
 - ▶ Dedicated Marijuana Account (DMA)
 - ▶ General Fund State (GFS or SFG)
- ▶ **FFY:** September 30 – September 29 annually
 - ▶ Partnership for Success (PFS)
 - ▶ State Opioid Response (SOR) – ends on 9/29/2020
- ▶ **Biennium:** July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021
 - ▶ SABG
- ▶ **NEW timeline starting 2020:** September 1 – August 30 annually (for two years)
 - ▶ State Opioid Response (SOR) II

The new template

What's changed?

- ▶ Contract layout/structure.
 - ▶ Including fixing formatting issues!
 - ▶ Less duplicity and more streamlined.
 - ▶ Goal was for a contract that was easy to read and look-up clauses as needed.
- ▶ Removing unnecessary and non-required requirements/clauses.

What hasn't changed?

- ▶ Intent and scope of contract including the Statement of Work.
- ▶ Similar language/clauses.

Anticipated timeline

- ▶ Contractors who are not interested in receiving the COLA, communicate this (by community) to their PSM by **July 30th**.
- ▶ CPWI contract template in-process of being finalized by the Office of Contracts and Procurement and the Prevention Section with a goal of getting a draft for review to CPWI contractors by **early August**.
 - ▶ **Note, any documents viewed/shared are a draft and are subject to change pending further review by HCA.*
- ▶ Feedback on CPWI contract template by **mid-August**.
- ▶ Contracts out for signature by end of **August**.
