

# Youth Marijuana Use Prevention Implementation Plan July 2019 - June 2021

For services funded through Initiative 502 (I-502)  
2E2SHB 2136, Chapter 4, 2015 Laws 2nd Special Session

## Washington Healthy Youth Survey (HYS) / Young Adult Health Survey (YAHS)

- Administering the surveys: \$1,000,000 biennial allocation.
- HYS is conducted every two years through collaboration with HCA, the Washington State Department of Health, the Liquor and Cannabis Board, and the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction. For more information visit [AskHYS.net](http://AskHYS.net).
- YAHS is administered yearly with HCA and the University of Washington.

## Statewide Cost-Benefit Evaluation

- HCA contracts with Washington State Institute for Public Policy (WSIPP): \$400,000 biennial allocation. For more information visit [wsipp.wa.gov/Reports](http://wsipp.wa.gov/Reports).

## Prevention – Increase Prevention Services

- Community-based Services: \$5,000,000 biennial allocation. This includes the Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative (CPWI) enhancement and expansion to five new sites, and over 30 grants to community-based organizations statewide to offer prevention programs from the I-502 program list.
- LifeSkills Training Program: \$500,000 biennial allocation. The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction is offering LifeSkills curriculum in over 35 schools statewide; grants cover curriculum materials and training.
- Home Visiting: \$2,000,000 biennial allocation. Contracting with the state Department of Early Learning to support and expand home visiting services.

## Tribal Prevention and Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment Grants

- Tribal youth prevention and SUD treatment grants for marijuana use, misuse, and use disorders: \$772,000 biennial allocation. Funding is available for Tribes to offer prevention or treatment services. Funding is available for federally recognized tribes and urban Indian organizations.

## Training for Prevention and Treatment Evidence-based Programs (EBP), Research-based Programs (RBP) and Promising Programs

- Training for EBPs, RBPs and Promising Programs: \$500,000 biennial allocation.

- Provider feedback is collected to determine program training needs and priorities.
