THE COALITION WORKS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH REPRESENTATION FROM YOUTH, EDUCATION, LAW ENFORCEMENT, LOCAL GOVERNMENT, HEALTHCARE, TREATMENT PROVIDERS, FAITHBASED ORGANIZATIONS, VOLUNTEER GROUPS, PARENTS, BUSINESS, AND THE MEDIA TO EFFECTIVELY SUPPORT OUR CHILDREN AND YOUTH TO LIVE SUBSTANCE FREE.





ABOUT THE SOUTH KITSAP COMMUNITY

SOUTH KITSAP, AS THE NAME SUGGESTS SITS AT THE SOUTHERN END OF KITSAP COUNTY. IT IS MADE UP OF APPROXIMATELY 100 SQUARE MILES OF MOSTLY RURAL LIVING. KITSAP COUNTY IS CONVENIENTLY LOCATED ON THE WESTERN SHORES OF PUGET SOUND AND SURROUNDED ON 3 ½ SIDES BY WATER. THE HUB OF SOUTH KITSAP IS THE SMALL TOWN OF PORT ORCHARD.

PORT ORCHARD IS THE COUNTY SEAT FOR KITSAP COUNTY, DIRECTLY ACROSS THE BAY FROM BREMERTON AND THE PUGET SOUND NAVAL SHIPYARD, AND HOME TO MANY UNIQUE AND DIVERSE RESIDENTS. THE POPULATION OF SOUTH KITSAP IS AROUND 66,000 PEOPLE WITH AROUND 15,000 LIVING IN THE INCORPORATED CITY OF PORT ORCHARD.

ABOUT PREVENTION PROGRAMS IN SOUTH KITSAP

THE COALITIONS MAIN GOAL IS TO DECREASE YOUTH SUBSTANCE MISUSE. THIS GOAL WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED THROUGH COMMUNITY-WIDE COLLABORATION, EDUCATION REGARDING THE EFFECTS OF DRUGS AND ALCOHOL AND STRATEGIES TO PREVENT AND REDUCE YOUTH SUBSTANCE USE.

ENVIRONMENTAL STRATEGIES DESIGNED TO DECREASE YOUTH'S ACCESS TO ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS, SCHOOL-BASED INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION SERVICES COMBINED WITH ACTIVITIES, EVENTS, POLICIES AND PROGRAMS THAT SUPPORT A SUBSTANCE-FREE LIFESTYLE WILL ASSIST YOUTH IN GOING FROM SURVIVING TO THRIVING,

BY OFFERING AND EVALUATING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF TOPIC SPECIFIC PREVENTION EDUCATION INCLUDING STRATEGIES TO RECOGNIZE AND PREVENT YOUTH SUBSTANCE USE WE WILL IMPROVE RESILIENCY, COPING STRATEGIES, FAMILY COMMUNICATION AND OVERALL COMMUNITY PERCEPTION RELATED TO ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND OTHER DRUGS,


