5.	From last SPE meeting Hot Topics Alcohol Compliance Assessment Project (CAP) Update	10:10	Kasey Discussion	We are still waiting for edits from SPE on the WHY action plan. The reason for the delay is that the question came up regarding whether COVID and virtual school affected the data. SPE is looking at pausing the strategic plan to look at this question closer for determining target percentages of 10 th grade substance use. There will be a discussion at the Prevention Summit Providers meeting also. Although the process is on pause, our coalition work is not on pause. Campaign discussion can help inform SPE plan. Action: Not at this time, but keep it on your radar! We are continuing to encourage participation in the CAP project. Here is the link for the project: https://tinyurl.com/AlcoholCAP-WA . This study could be helpful with community environmental strategies. Action: Participation is strongly encouraged.
