2.	WA pilot alcohol observation project	9:10	Julia Dilley	Julia reviewed the field test results from the June/July. The field test included volunteers from the WHY Coalition. Julia's review is included in the meeting PowerPoint. She reviewed the results of the field test. About half of the sample tests were out of compliance. Julia reviewed the next steps for Alcohol Action Network. The good news is that the tool works. Attendees had the opportunity to tell purchase stories.

Questions: What are the plans going forward at DOH? What role will WHY take? Nikki Meline (DOH) will bring this conversation forward. Megan Moore added HB1210 to the chat that went quite far during last session. Are there norm shifts at other agencies? Several agency representatives added how they are branding the substance and in what context the term has been used. Sara suggested that terminology be revisited and to consider where we are considering terminology. At this time, this should be watched for movement. Sara requested this subject be revisited formally at WHY during a meeting next year.</p> <p>Alcohol Allowances – Sara reviewed the Rulemaking process LCB has begun concerning Alcohol and HB 1480. Additional comments will be gathered in September. Sara reviewed some of the thoughts shared during the prediscussions with prevention staff and that are currently in the draft of the rule.</p> <p>Impact study RFP will be open September 1 – 22. An application from a researcher is requested. The information gathered with this study could be shared nationally.</p> <p>Cannabis Administration and Opportunity Act – Comments concerning this bill are appreciated; send comments to Senator Murray. CADCA has created a template for comments. Comments are due to feds by September 1. What other agencies have been looking at this? DBHR, LCB.</p> <p>Suggestons for September Hot Topics – Members suggested the topics of - increased stressors/isolation and SUD and MH, Jason and the COVID youth study (https://csswashington.org/) – a deeper look, Legislative Session – messaging re: MH/suicidal ideation, SUD connection/messaging, the overlap of COVID and SUD or MH, the adjusted DOH campaign – You Can, a conversation about the HYS that will be implemented in fall – what does it mean that the cohort is different than the prior administration of the HYS in depth (barriers and concerns), Legislation on the horizon – outlet density, tax on canned cocktails, MJ home delivery, potency, equitable enforcement of tobacco, home grows.</p> <p>Attendees can send relevant agenda topics to Martha and/or Kasey for future meetings.</p>
