

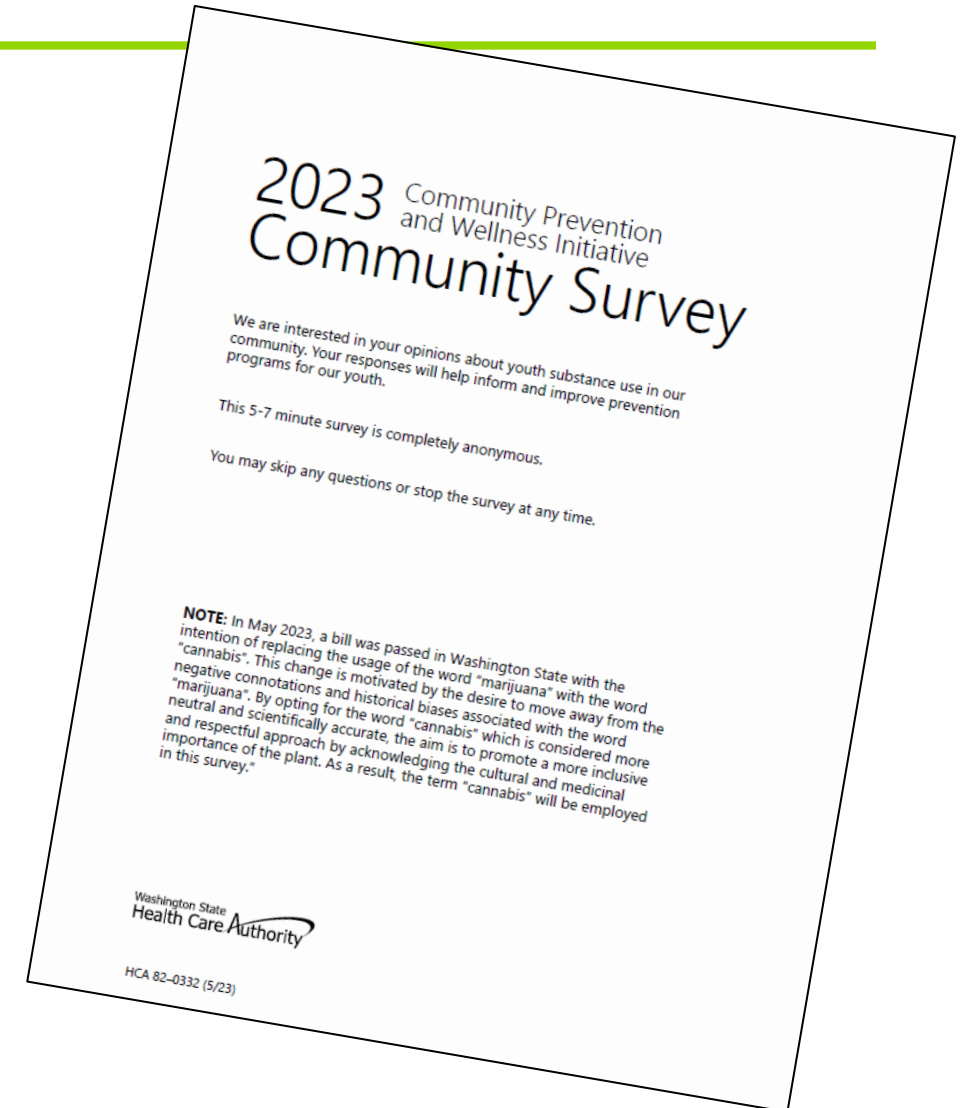

CPWI Community Survey Overview

- ▶ Major aim
 - ▶ Capture adult attitudes about teen alcohol & drug use in the community
- ▶ Main uses
 - ▶ To inform strategic planning
 - ▶ As baseline and to monitor change
 - ▶ To start a conversation in the community
 - ▶ To encourage positive community and parent norms
- ▶ Developed by coalition volunteers & state staff



Survey Administration

- ▶ Administered annually from 2010-2023; Starting 2025 every other year
 - ▶ July through November
 - ▶ Target sample size based on adult population
 - ▶ Participants recruited through a convenience sample
 - ▶ Capture adult attitudes about teen alcohol & drug use in the community
- ▶ Online and paper
 - ▶ English and Spanish on-line
 - ▶ Translated into 6 languages (Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Cambodian, Somali, and Russian)

Survey Content

- ▶ Attitudes towards youth substance use
 - ▶ Beliefs about severity of the problem
 - ▶ Beliefs about risk of harm in youth substance use
- ▶ Perceived community / parent norms related to youth substance use
- ▶ Perceived youth access to substances
 - ▶ Perceptions of youth ease of access to alcohol & marijuana
- ▶ Parental monitoring and supervision behaviors
- ▶ Demographics

Discussion Questions

- ▶ **Effectiveness:** How well do the current survey questions capture the community's perceptions and concerns about youth substance use?
- ▶ **Relevance:** Do the current questions reflect the most pressing substance use issues affecting youth today? Are there any emerging trends that the survey isn't addressing?
- ▶ **New Topics:** Are there any new areas of concern or interest related to youth substance use that we should consider adding to the survey?
- ▶ **Response Options:** Are the response options provided for each question appropriate and comprehensive? Should we add or modify any of these options to improve data accuracy?
