Prevention Voices is focusing the LCB's allowances given since COVID-19 including unenforced rules, making the allowances permanent, future bills re: marijuana. This is a grassroots movement. The group doesn't believe there will be a special session at this time, but the group was working on a timeline as if there might be a special session. Voices has the following workgroups are Action Team, Strategy Team, and Tool Kit Team. Sara shared the mission and vision of Prevention Voices:</p> <p><b>Prevention Voices Mission:</b> To foster statewide collaborations to assure public health and prevention professionals are active, consistent, and credible voices at the local and state level in policy discussions regarding changes to alcohol and marijuana regulatory controls.</p> <p><b>Prevention Voices Vision:</b> Washington state alcohol and marijuana prevention professionals are active partners who inform lawmakers, local policymakers, and the LCB with educational materials and data regarding potential unintended consequences of relaxing rules and enacting legislative changes to alcohol and marijuana restrictions.</p> <p>The group wants to be more knowledgeable and are planning to do brown bag lunches every other Wednesday to learn more. The Brown Bag Lunch invitation will be sent out to members by Martha.</p> <p>Concerning rulemaking, LCB will be holding a learning session soon; Prevention Voices will be attending. Voices members attend LCB Board meetings, as well, to ensure prevention voices are heard.</p> <p>Media advocacy is also a big lift for the Tool Kit Team; prevention professionals are encouraged to join.
