SNAPSHOT OF THE YCCTPP COMMUNITY GRANTS MENTORING PARTNERSHIP PROJECT

The purpose of YCCTPP is to address youth cannabis and commercial tobacco prevention through policy, systems, and environmental change (PSE) efforts.

The community Based Prevent Capacity Building Grants program is intended to support new and emerging partners in addressing prevention and community wellness.

Policy, Systems, and Environmental Change (PSE) Strategies of YCCTPP Community Grants Mentoring Partnership

- Limit youth access to cannabis or commercial tobacco products
- Address social and community norms around youth cannabis and commercial tobacco use
- Community-led initiatives that address inequities that might lead to youth cannabis and commercial tobacco use
- Development of community skills in advocacy for policy change, including those addressing social determinants of health
- Opportunities and spaces for people to positively socialize, challenge social norms that promote misuse, share cultural traditions, and build community
- Address consequences associated with youth use & focus on addressing equitable & holistic approaches
