

Reasons for Exit

The Reason for Exit field appears in the Student Services channel within the Exit Report sub-channel. An Exit Report is required to be completed at the end of every state fiscal year for every student with an intake & screening in that state fiscal year.

The Reason for Exit identifies why Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative (CPWI) school-based services with the student have concluded. In most cases, services conclude at the end of the school year, and the appropriate reason for exit will be “**End of school year.**” If services end earlier, or for a different reason, select the option that best reflects why services concluded.

Reason	Definition
End of school year	The default reason for exit. The students’ services concluded because the academic year ended. This is the default reason for exit when services naturally stop at the end of the school year.
Student graduated	The student graduated from the school and is therefore no longer eligible to receive services.
Student transferred or moved	The student transferred to another school or moved out of the area and is no longer available to receive services within this specific account.
Student expelled	The student was expelled from the school and is therefore no longer available to receive services within this specific account.
Student or family declined further services	The student or their family chose to not pursue or continue services.
Services are not/no longer appropriate	Based on professional judgment, the student does not require or no longer requires CPWI school-based prevention services, or their needs have identified or changed in such a way that CPWI school-based prevention services no longer offer the appropriate level of support.
