Washington Thriving

- ▶ Washington residents are invited to share input on the future of K–12 student behavioral health supports. As part of the [Policy Codesign for K–12 School Behavioral Health project](#), UW CoLab for Community and Behavioral Health Policy and OSPI are gathering community input through the first Community Sounding Board questionnaire.
- ▶ Participants will review a set of design challenges (key questions and choices related to student behavioral health supports) and share where they stand. Feedback will be summarized and shared with the Core Design Team to inform their recommendations.
- ▶ The questionnaire is open to any Washington resident, and responses are **due by Friday, May 29**.

CPWI SFY 2027 allocations

- ▶ Allocations are finalized and your manager can share amounts with you via email as we finalize A&R / FSI Documents.
- ▶ CPWI Budgets:
 - ▶ The SFY 2027 tab has been updated to account for the “EBP” designation and once final, will be shared for use on Athena.
 - ▶ You may continue to use the “old” version of the Budget for SFY 2027 or you can use this “new” version.
 - ▶ Due date TBD as we navigate finalizing the A&R / FSI Documents
 - ▶ **Note: Updates to your SFY 2027 should be underway (as needed) and due date for final updates TBD pending Budget information.**

Changes to DCA & OASA

- ▶ Dedicated Cannabis Account (DCA) split into two (2) buckets:
 - ▶ DCA - 315 – XZA
 - ▶ DCA - 315 – Base
- ▶ Opioid Abatement Settlement Account (OASA) split into three (3) buckets:
 - ▶ OASA - 27W - RMA2
 - ▶ OASA - 27W – XZA
 - ▶ OASA - 27W - DS9A
- ▶ For the most part, providers that receive this funding only received one (1) bucket however a few received two (2) per site.
- ▶ **Why?** Different provisos / funding codes and we continue to be asked more frequently to provide details (including allocations and expenditures) by each bucket in particular on state funding.

Allocations: Let's take a step back...

- ▶ For SFY 2027 there were:
 - ▶ 9 different “buckets” of fund sources that fed into CPWI Coalition allocations
 - ▶ 7 different “buckets” of fund sources that fed into CPWI School-Based Services allocations
 - ▶ of varying amounts from \$228,000 to \$6,478,785
- ▶ Still committed to provide the least number of fund sources per site while still maximizing flexibility of various fund sources—and provide “whole” and “round” numbers wherever possible.
- ▶ Prior to the 2021 – 2023, allocations were rehailed to meet those commitments and due to evolving fund sources.
- ▶ Anticipate a rehaul for the 2027 – 2029 biennium to continue to try to meet those commitments.

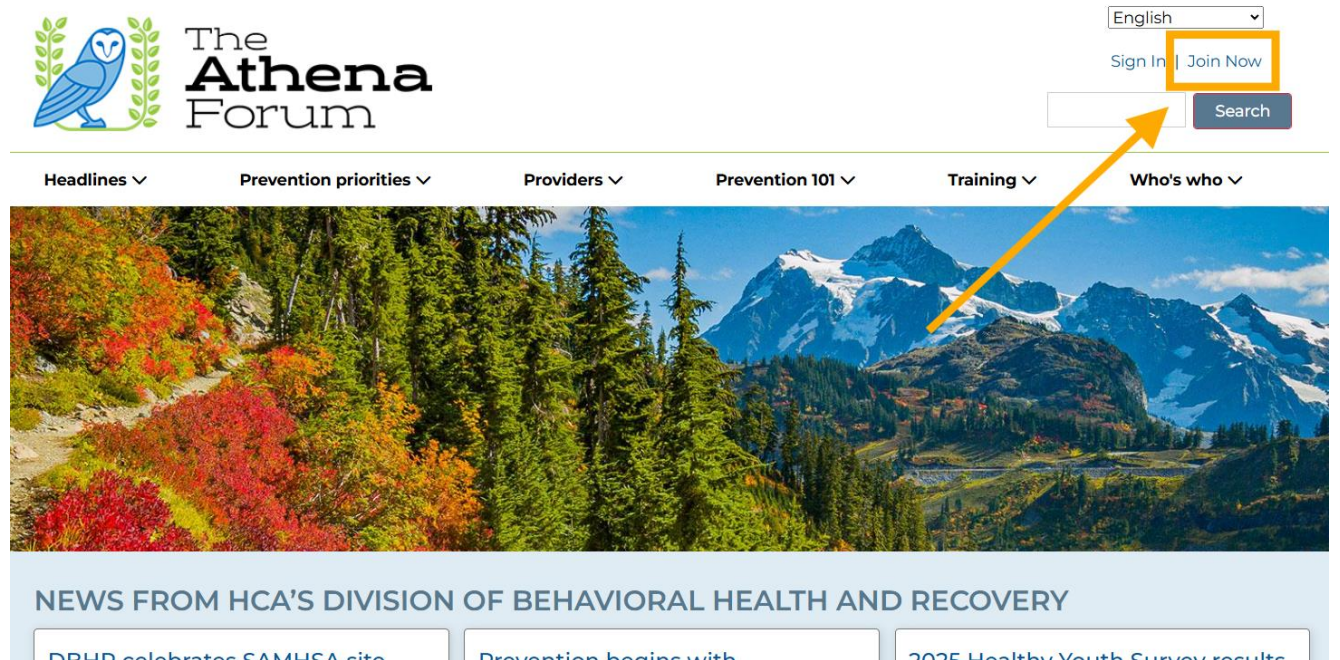

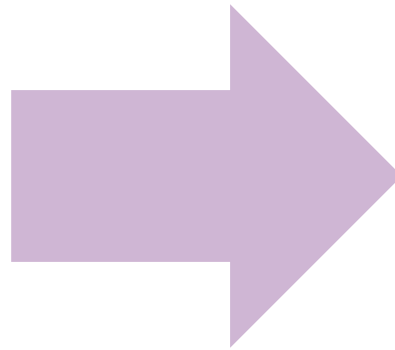

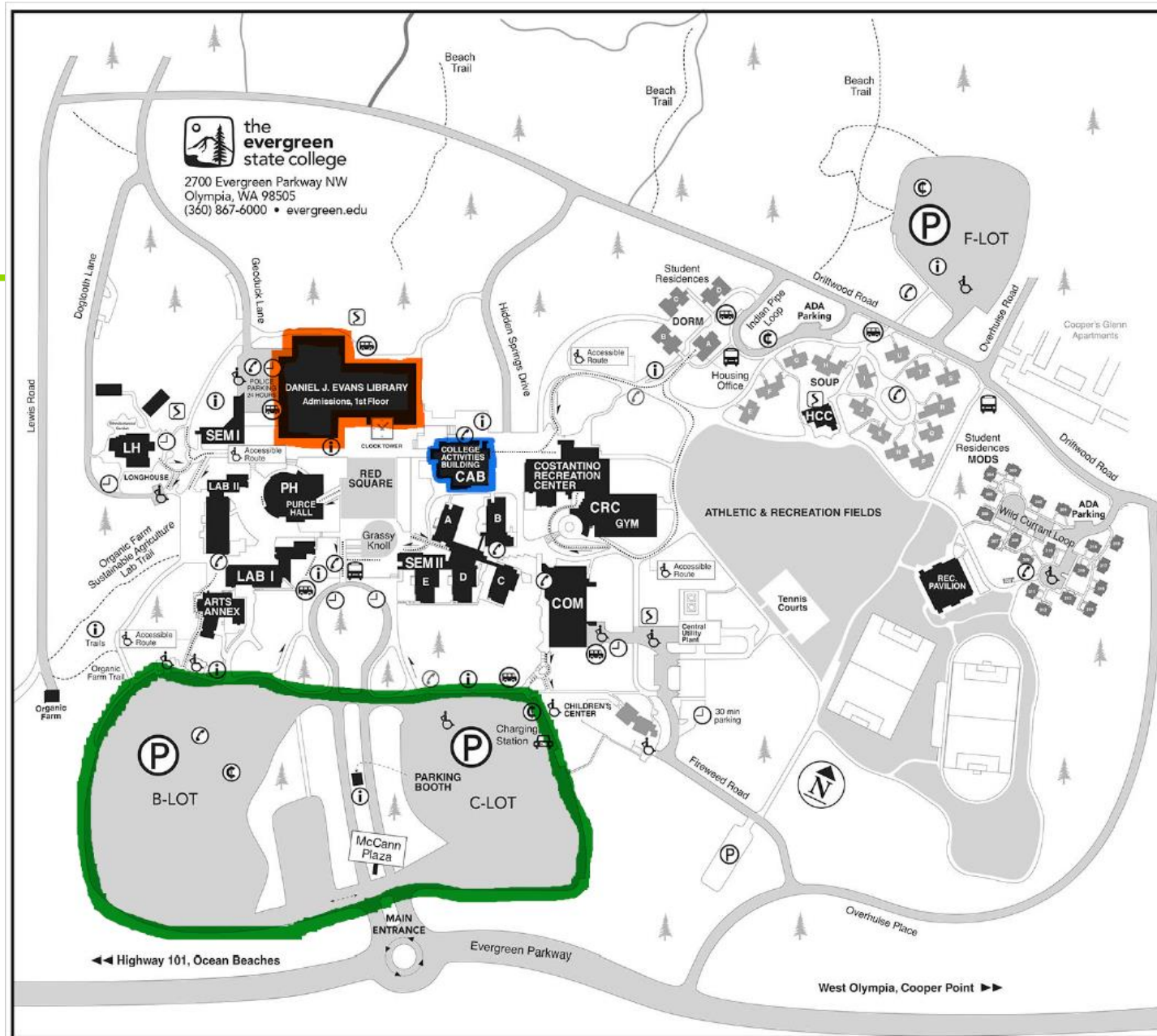

QUESTION	ANSWER
<p>Has DOH talked about offering a CBO grant in SFY 2028?</p>	<p>As of now, the future plans are not fully known as they navigate this change themselves. We continue to stay in touch with leadership at DOH and they will continue to communicate as they have more info.</p>
<p>Does HCA offer any training on how to diversify funding at the local level? It would be nice to brainstorm or hear from other coalitions on how they have increased sustainability with funding outside of HCA.</p>	<p>While we navigated some programmatic reductions over the last few years, the larger reductions have been on the state level to administrative meaning things like hiring freezes. We will be encouraging that providers take advantage of other resources (even if through HCA) like the UW's Community of Practice.</p>

Why did the state make this change? Was this a legislative directive?	Correct, it was a legislative directive.
Any updates on when coalition data books will be updated?	Planned for August / September at this time.
Are you saying that sites with DCA funds will have multiple DCA funding? Will there be individual restrictions for each DCA fund source?	There are a few sites who will receive more than one fund source code or "bucket" under DCA (and OASA) but, for the most part, each site received only one.

<p>With the most recent HYS data showing substance use at historic lows, and the loss of Mental Health Promotion funding, what are the departments plan for the future? Big broad question, but are there plans for working from risk and protective factors instead of dialing in to specific contributing factors?</p>	<p>Great question. We continue to follow our strategic plans as a section, in alignment with the SPE plan, which focus on both risk and protective factors/local conditions on the way to long-term substance use (and broader societal) outcomes, while keeping in step with the priorities that guide the available state and local federal funding sources.
