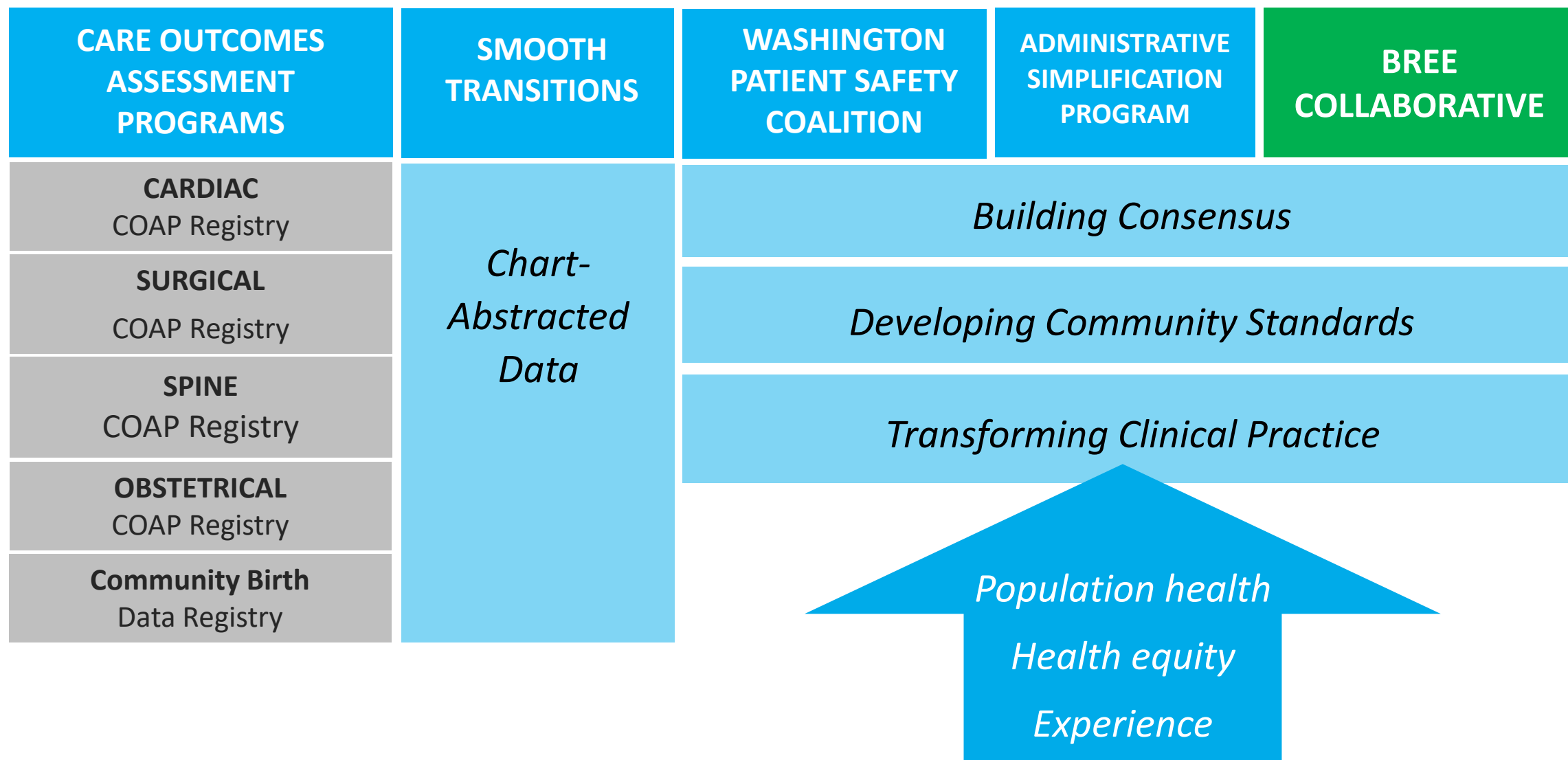

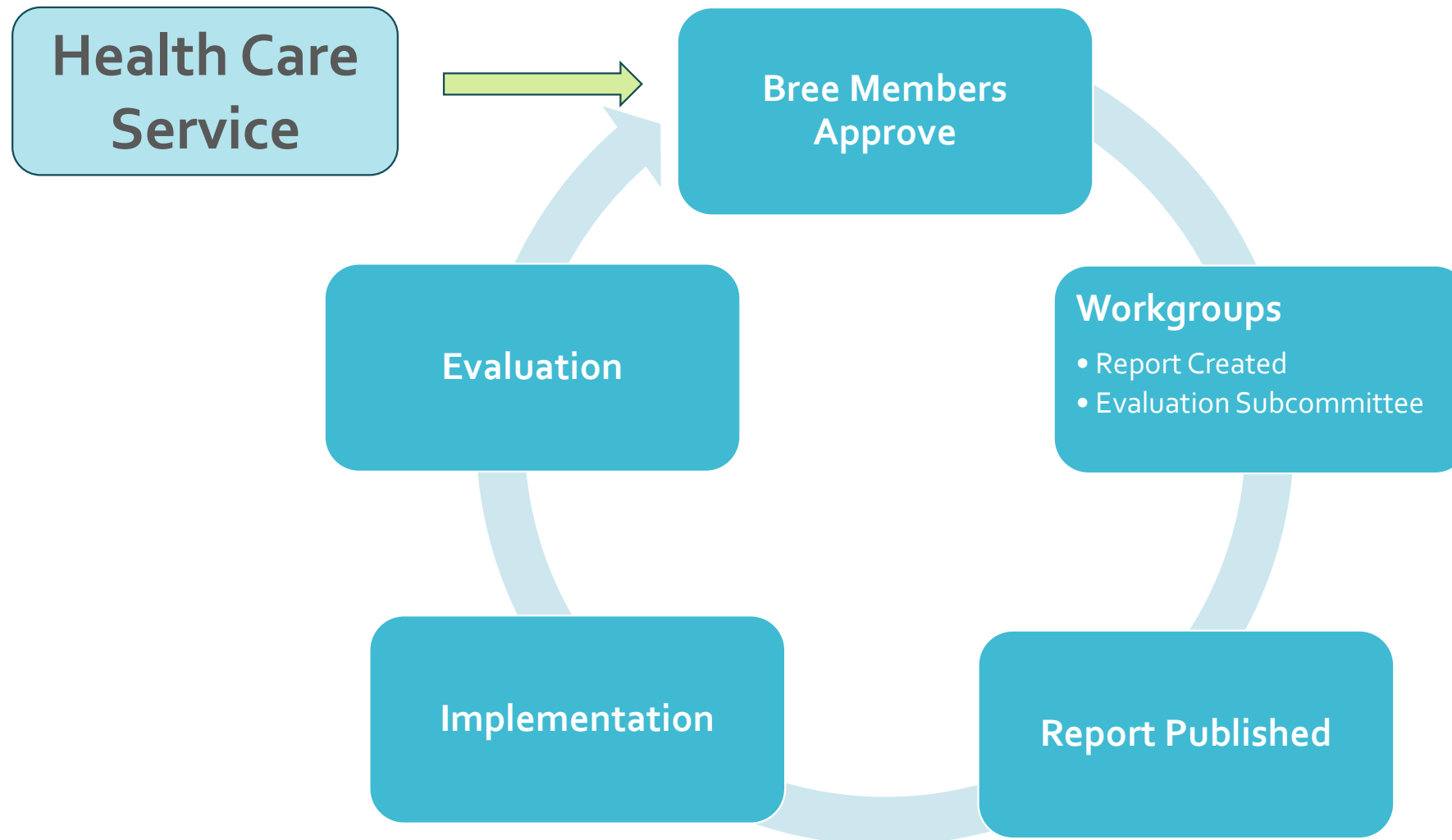

Lung Cancer Screening



Aim: to increase uptake and adherence to lung cancer screening in Washington state

- **Components of lung cancer screening**
 - identifying eligible populations
 - shared decision-making about screening
 - Annual low-dose CTs, navigation support
 - guideline-driven results management
- **Stigma** in lung cancer screening
- Integration of **smoking cessation support** across the entire lung cancer screening continuum is the gold standard



Perimenopause and Menopause



Aim: to standardize high quality care and best practices through perimenopause and menopause in Washington state in order to prevent disease, promote wellbeing, reduce cost, and increase productivity

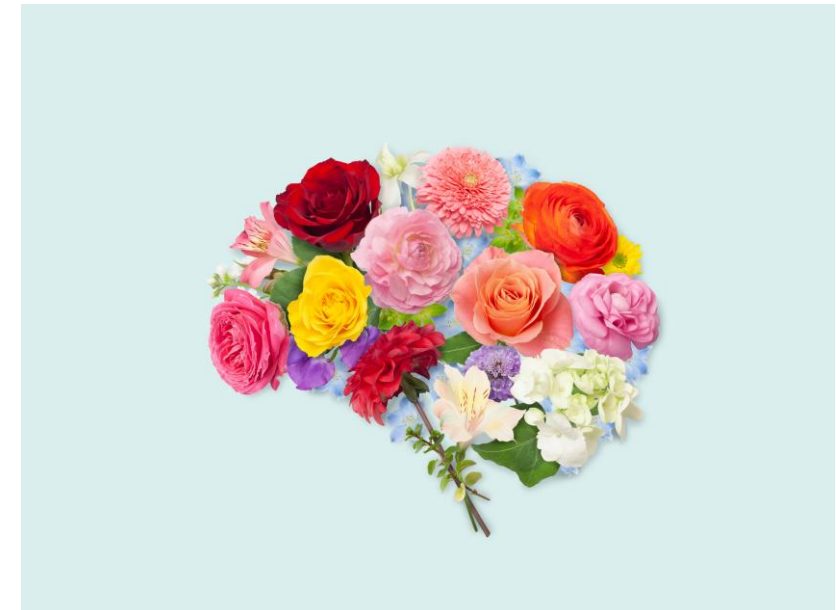
- **Components include:**
 - Public and clinician education about menopause
 - Menopause as a timepoint to assess and address midlife health comprehensively
 - Shared decision-making in management of symptoms
 - Workplace policies, accommodations, and benefit design
- **Support prevention as we age**, including heart, brain, metabolic, musculoskeletal, and behavioral health

Alzheimer's and Other Dementias



Aim: to update and standardize evidence-based risk reduction, early detection, and treatment for those living with and at risk for Alzheimer's and other dementias to prevent and delay progression of these conditions for our community.

- **Components include**
 - Risk reduction across the life course
 - Early detection and diagnosis of cognitive concerns
 - Improving holistic support for patients and families, including supporting the caregiver(s)
 - Navigating novel diagnostic tools and therapies in primary care
- **45% dementias are theoretically preventable - modifiable risk factors** for dementias include education, hearing and vision loss, hypertension, diabetes, obesity, depression, social isolation, air quality, sleep, and others
