2.	<b>Implementing the Alcohol Assessment Tool</b>	9:15	<b>Julia Dilley</b>	<p><b>What can WHY members do?</b></p> <p>Julia reintroduced the tool kit and the background of the tool kit for assessing compliance with policies regarding home and curbside delivery of alcohol. The toolkit includes several guides and web links; the Alcohol Action Network of the American Public Health Association will compile and provide data. The tool is used to document what is happening in communities regarding compliance. It is important to note that the people who do the survey are not being asked to go above and beyond what they would normally purchase. It is also not an enforcement tool but rather an assessment tool. Julia reviewed how the data will be reviewed.</p> <p>The Tool is being used by six states at this time.</p> <p>Oregon’s Liquor regulatory agency is working hard to collect data in two waves.</p> <p>Additional information and links to the toolkit are in the PowerPoint file that will go out with these notes.</p> <p>Attendees were given the time to ask questions and comment on what WHY can do as next steps.</p> <p>Potential participants: College Coalition, WHY member’s contacts. A training component needs to be considered. Do we want participants across the state or community specific, e.g., urban vs rural communities. (Oregon is IDing local coordinators and asking for five observations each). Ad hoc group will craft a plan for WHY to implement.
