

#### What is a HIDTA?

- High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area program
- Created by Congress with Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988
- Overseen by the Office of National Drug Control Policy under the Executive Office of the President
- Funding is authorized by Congress annually
- Purpose of addressing substance use and availability by increasing collaboration



#### Northwest HIDTA

- 15 HIDTA counties
  - 90% WA population
- Follows I-5 N/S and I-90 E/W corridor

  - Federal, state, tribal, and local agencies
- Investigative Support Center (ISC)
- Training initiative
- Prevention & treatment initiatives
  - Grant programs
  - Overdose Response Strategy





















#### 2023 RFP

- Two grant programs: prevention and treatment
- Up to \$50k (prevention) or \$60k (treatment)
  - Intention to fill gaps, not fund entire program
- Support the HIDTA mission: addressing illicit substances
- Focus on collaboration





#### 2023 RFP

- Funding begins July 1, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023
- Proposals due March 15<sup>th</sup>
- Notification of decisions in April
- Application posted to Athena Forum
