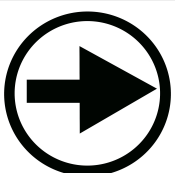
The first 2022 ASCOT training series is spread out across six (6) weeks. From 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM, daily via Zoom platform.
